Farm Activities



There is a huge variety of farm activities all year round at "Hanericka". Being a genuine working farm you will understand that some of these activities may be available only at certain times a year. Generally speaking, preparation for cropping is in April, sewing the crops is in May, June and July, haymaking is in October and harvest in November and December. Work with cattle and sheep, including shearing and many other maintenance projects are interspersed throughout the year depending upon the weather and level of priority.



Morning activities



Everyday ... rain, hail or shine, the regular farm chores need to be done and any offers of help are welcome and encouraged. Every morning after breakfast we must milk



Maisy the goat/s, feed the poultry, collect the eggs, hand-feed horses, bottle-feed lambs and sometimes a calf and feed Wilbur the pet pig. We also have a donkey, alpacas, emus, friendly working dogs and often kittens. Having satisfied the animals we may now satisfy ourselves with a worthy morning tea break!



Now well nourished ... it is time for the pony and horse rides for those who are interested.

Young children love to hand-feed and brush the horses and especially love to be led all around the farmyard or even try themselves! For more experienced riders we do not offer cantering rides (only walking rides) out in the open fields. Upon request, we often have supervised trotting and slow cantering in well fenced areas of our cattle yards.



Farm activities

Climb aboard the old wagon for a hayride ... explore beyond the immediate farmyard and see cattle and sheep grazing in the paddocks and the wide expanse of crops and grasslands. Adults and children alike can learn about the farm while they have fun.



For the rest of the day there are facilities such as the tennis courts, bikes, soccer field, swimming pool, table-tennis, toy corner in the shed, cubby houses and swings, re-visit the animals by yourself etc. ... all provided for your enjoyment!

Evening activities



During fire-safe times of the year help us to collect wood for a bonfire outside where we sometimes set up a movie. At other times with large family groups or tour groups we lead you in

a games or trivia night. Why not pull on your dancing shoes and join in with a night of bushdancing, rock 'n roll and even disco in the farmbarn? We have all the proper sound and lighting equipment to make it into a very memorable night! Perhaps you know of someone who would love to celebrate a birthday or anniversary with a country dance evening?



Accommodation

The accommodation consists of rooms with private ensuites with the choice of king size and/or twin beds. Towels and linen are supplied. Rooms are well heated in the winter (electric blankets provided) and air-conditioned in the summer.



For overseas tour groups, in particular those with an agricultural interest, we offer you the option of being home-hosted onto local farms enabling you the wonderful opportunity to experience farm life with your host family.

Meals

The wonderful fresh country air certainly makes for a healthy appetite. All meals are provided during your stay with us at Hanericka so relax and enjoy the delightful selection of food that we have to offer... wholesome, plentiful and home cooked. From hearty hot breakfasts, delicious morning and afternoon teas, wholesome lunches and sumptuous dinners, the meals are always a highlight at Hanericka. Cycling

Hanericka Farmstay is one of the great places for the road cyclist. If you are a road bike cyclist you should not forget to bring your bike along with you. The temperate weather conditions along with endless miles of quiet, sealed country roads are ideal for cycling. Enjoy your ride through the beautiful and undulating farming country sharing the roads with only the occasional car. You can cycle along 50, 80, 95 or 150 km country roads from Yerong Creek to Mangoplah, to The Rock and even as far as Coolamon, Tumbarumba or Jingellic. Whether cycling for 1 hour or 4 hours we are happy to make all the necessary arrangements to supplement your ride with drinks or picnic lunch and arrange pick-ups if required. We also offer supported rides for groups of cyclists. During the year we organise our own cycling boot camps so keep in tune with our web page or feel free to call us for more information regarding dates, cycling routes and prices.
